VENETIAN ISLES COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT

A. CALL TO ORDER

District Manager Neil Kalin called the June 27, 2017, Regular Board Meeting of the Venetian Isles Community Development District to order at 7:01 p.m. in the Venetian Isles Community Clubhouse located at 15355 Egret Lake Circle, Miami, Florida 33185.

B. PROOF OF PUBLICATION

Mr. Kalin presented proof of publication that notice of the Regular Board Meeting had been published in the *Miami Daily Business Review* on October 14, 2016, June 7, 2017, and June 14, 2017, as legally required.

C. ESTABLISH A QUORUM

Mr. Kalin determined that the attendance of Chairman Andres Vazquez and Supervisors Luis Baluja, José Medina and Richard Borrazas constituted a quorum and it was in order to proceed with the meeting.

Staff members in attendance were: District Manager Neil Kalin of Special District Services, Inc.; and District Counsel Michael Pawelczyk of Billing, Cochran, Lyles, Mauro & Ramsey, P.A.

Also presented were Alex Candelario of Affinity Property Management, Miami, Florida.

D. ADDITIONS OR DELETIONS TO THE AGENDA

There were no additions or deletions to the Agenda.

E. COMMENTS FROM THE PUBLIC FOR ITEMS NOT ON THE AGENDA

There were no comments from the public for items not on the agenda.

F. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

1. April 25, 2017, Regular Board Meeting

Mr. Kalin presented the minutes of the April 25, 2017, Regular Board Meeting and asked if there were any changes. Mr. Baluja, for the record, noted a spelling error in Mr. Medina's name on page 2 of the minutes, second paragraph of Old Business Item 1. There being no additional comments or changes, a **motion** was made by Mr. Baluja, seconded by Mr. Medina and unanimously passed to approve the minutes of the April 25, 2017, Regular Board Meeting, *as amended*.

<u>Note</u>: At approximately 7:04 p.m., Mr. Kalin recessed the Regular Meeting and simultaneously opened the Public Hearing..

G. PUBLIC HEARING

1. Proof of Publication

Mr. Kalin presented proof of publication that notice of the Public Hearing had been published in the *Miami Daily Business Review* on June 7, 2017, and June 14, 2017, as legally required.

2. Receive Public Comment on Fiscal Year 2017/2018 Final Budget & Assessments

Mr. Kalin opened the public comment portion of the Public Hearing to receive comments on the fiscal year 2017/2018 final budget and non-ad valorem special assessments. There being no comments from the public on the fiscal year 2017/2018 budget and assessments, Mr. Kalin closed the public comment portion of the Public Hearing.

3. Consider Resolution No. 2017-03 – Adopting a Fiscal Year 2017/2018 Final Budget

Mr. Kalin presented Resolution No. 2017-03, entitled:

RESOLUTION NO. 2017-03

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE VENETIAN ISLES COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT APPROVING AND ADOPTING A FISCAL YEAR 2017/2018 FINAL BUDGET INCLUDING NON-AD VALOREM SPECIAL ASSESSMENTS; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Mr. Kalin read the title of the resolution into the record and stated that it provides for approving and adopting the fiscal year 2017/2018 final budget and non-ad valorem special assessment tax roll. For review purposes, a copy of the District's tax roll was provided at the meeting. A discussion ensued after which:

A **motion** was made by Mr. Baluja, seconded by Mr. Vazquez and unanimously passed to approve and adopt Resolution No. 2017-03, *as presented*, thereby setting the fiscal year 2017/2018 final budget and non-ad valorem special assessment tax roll.

<u>Note</u>: At approximately 7:06 p.m., Mr. Kalin closed the Public Hearing and simultaneously reconvened the Regular Board Meeting.

H. OLD BUSINESS

1. Update on Community Street Sign Project

Mr. Kalin advised that the Community Street Sign Project (the "Project") had four (4) street signs that required installation of concrete aprons around the individual break-away post base of each sign post. This final aspect of the Project is anticipated to be completed by the end of July.

I. NEW BUSINESS

1. Consider Resolution No. 2017-04 – Adopting a Fiscal Year 2017/2018 Regular Meeting Schedule

Mr. Kalin presented Resolution No. 2017-04, entitled:

RESOLUTION NO. 2017-04

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE VENETIAN ISLES COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT, ESTABLISHING A REGULAR MEETING SCHEDULE FOR FISCAL YEAR 2017/2018 AND SETTING THE TIME AND LOCATION OF SAID DISTRICT MEETINGS; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Mr. Kalin provided an explanation for the document. A discussion ensued after which:

A **motion** was made by Mr. Baluja, seconded by Mr. Borrazas and passed unanimously to approve and adopt Resolution No. 2017-04, *as presented*; thereby setting the fiscal year 2017/2018 regular meeting schedule and authorizing the publication of the meeting schedule, as required by law.

J. ADMINISTRATIVE & OPERATIONAL MATTERS

1. Financial Risk Management Policy Review - Fiscal Year 2016/2017

Mr. Kalin advised that Special District Services, Inc., acting in the capacity of District Manager, as part of best management practices and to satisfy annual audit requirements, does implement certain measures and procedures to identify and mitigate financial mismanagement/fraud risks, as follows:

- **a.** Each month the District's operating/checking bank account is reconciled by an authorized person who has not deposited funds to, processed expenditures or written checks from, that particular operating/checking account; and
- **b.** Each expenditure from the District's operating/checking account requires a minimum of two (2) approvals from authorized staff and/or District officials and the respective approvals are provided by persons other than the preparer of the expenditure; and
- c. All financial transactions are logged and maintained by the District Manager for record keeping purposes; and
- **d.** A designated member of the Board, typically the Chairperson (by an electronic approval procedure), has an opportunity to review the District's expenditure(s) prior to the payment(s) being released; and

- **e.** The District engages an independent firm, pursuant to Chapter 218.391, Florida Statutes, to audit the prior year's financial activities (October 1st through September 30th) from which an independent fiscal year annual audit is prepared; and
- **f.** Within sixty (60) days of the end of each fiscal year (September 30th) the District's Board of Supervisors reviews, pursuant to Chapter 189.418(5), Florida Statutes, the prior year's budget relative to actual revenues and expenditures and adopts by resolution an amended/revised final budget.

2. Discussion Regarding Lake Bank/Shoreline Erosion – Lake Tracts

Mr. Kalin advised there was minimal evidence of lake bank erosion on the District owned lake tracts. The lake banks inspected by Mr. Kalin continue to have a soft slope (approximately 4:1) and there appeared to be no evidence of shoreline or lake bank issues. Mr. Baluja recommended that the District Engineer, in his Annual Engineer's Report, provide a report on the condition and appearance of the lake banks within the lake tracts within the District.

3. Financial Disclosure – 2016 Form 1 – Deadline: July 3, 2017

The Board was reminded of the importance of completing and mailing to the Supervisor of Elections within the County of residency their individual 2016 Statement of Financial Interests Form 1. The deadline for submittal is July 3, 2017.

K. BOARD MEMBER & STAFF CLOSING COMMENTS

Mr. Baluja suggested to the other Board Members that it is time again to consider sending a news pamphlet to the residents of the community, which outlines the District's accomplishments over the past couple of years. A discussion ensued after which the consensus at this time is for any community news/updates be posted on the District's website as well as on the Master HOA website.

Mr. Kalin stated that unless an emergency were to arise there would be no need for the July meeting.

L. ADJOURNMENT

There being no further business to come before the Board, a **motion** was made by Mr. Vazquez, seconded by Mr. Borrazas and unanimously passed to adjourn the Regular Board Meeting at 7:38 p.m.

RE: Venetian Isles Community Development District Auditor Renewal
At the October 28, 2014 Venetian Isles Community Development District Board Of Supervisors meeting, the firm of Grau & Associates was selected to perform the 9-30-2014, 9-30-2015 and 9-30-2016 year end audits of the District with an option to perform the 9-30-2017 audit.
The fees for the 9-30-2014 audit were \$3,500. The fees for the 9-30-2015 audit were \$3,600. And the fees for the 9-30-2016 audit were \$3,700. The proposed fee for the 9-30-2017 audit is \$3,700, which is the budgeted amount for audit fees for Fiscal Year 2017/2018.
Grau & Associates has been the district auditor for the past eight years. Management is pleased with the professionalism and the competence of the Grau & Associates partners and staff; therefore management recommends that the Board approve the renewal option for the Fiscal Year Ending 9-30-2017 audit for Grau & Associates.
